Remember, the adverbs tell you either when, where, how or how often the verb happens.

- 1. I went to the beach yesterday. (Tells us when I went.)
- 2. Occasionally, I like to draw and paint. (Tells us how I draw/paint.)
- 3. Her stomach <u>noisily</u> rumbled. (Tells us how it rumbled)
- 4. She looked at the gift with hope in her heart. (Tells us how she looked.)
- 5. <u>Inside the house</u>, mum could hear the squeals of laughter. (Tells us where she could hear it.)
- 6. She cautiously searched the room. (Tells us how she searched)
