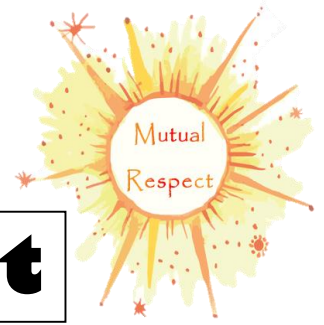

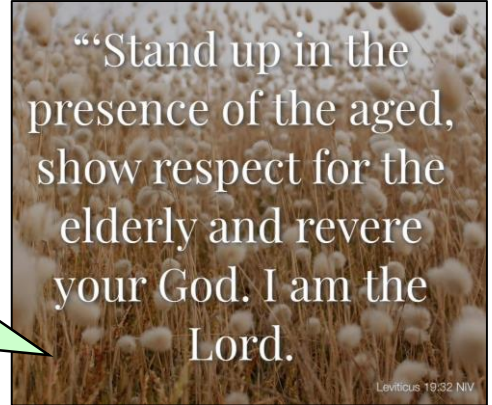
## Mutual Respect

What the bible says about Respect



*Respect is the foundation of all human behaviour. To have respect for a person involves a fundamental belief in their right to exist, to be heard, and to have the same opportunities as everyone else. Respect doesn't mean ignoring people's differences, or simply tolerating them. Rather, it involves recognising differences, understanding their importance and responding with interest, politeness and care.*

*Treating someone with respect means that you interact with them in a way that shows that you care about their well-being and how they feel. When you respect someone, you treat them kindly and use good manners. Sometimes it means doing things for them or listening to their instructions.*

*We can think of important dates and events through the Autumn term where we have already shown respect, such as listening and voting in our House Captain and School Council elections. We have celebrated Black History Month and respected all the ways in which God has provided for us through Harvest.*

*We will also understand how we can show our respect through standing up to racism and respect older generations that have fought in various wars to give us the rights and privileges we have in Britain during our Remembrance service.*
