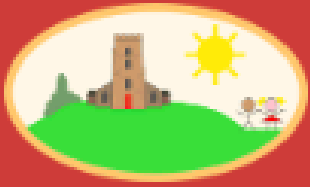

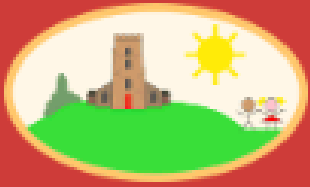
SIAMS 2024

Those who are vulnerable and disadvantaged are well supported. ..those who have special educational needs and/ or disabilities or who are disadvantaged are able to thrive.



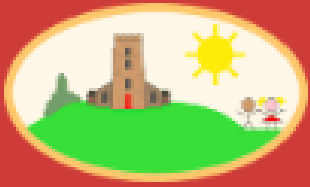
School Uniform

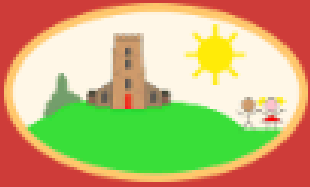

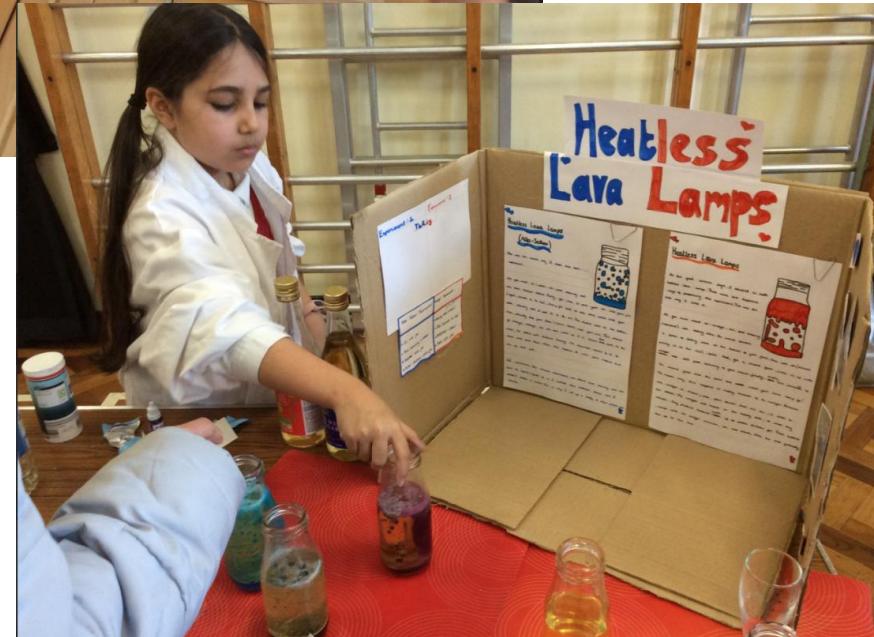

Some of the events we run are:-

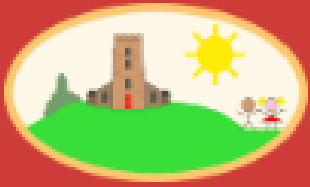

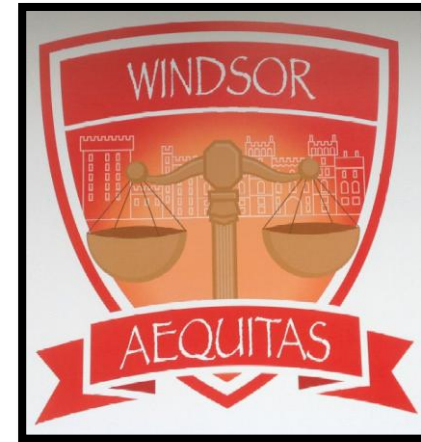

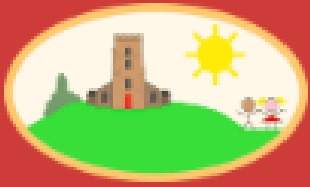

House Points are earned in a variety of ways, from good behaviour to outstanding work, sporting excellence to creative flair.

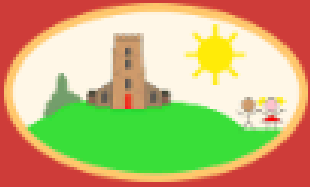
Each house will compete for the House Cup, awarded every term to the house with the most house points.

If children choose to break the school rules, the following steps will be taken during the day:



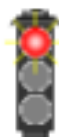
First time a rule is broken

A warning to be given (recorded on grid)



Second time a rule broken

Kept back in class for five minutes at break or home time/ Leave room to work with Head of Year (recorded on grid)



Third time a rule is broken

Letter sent to parents & text home via school secretary. Child is sent to a member of the SLT who will take appropriate action taken (recorded on grid).

Severe Disruption Child is sent straight to a member of SLT who may inform parents and take further action as required.

Warnings are cumulative throughout the day but all children begin afresh each morning.

Will my child be safe in school?

Definitely. The school site is locked once the children have arrived. Children will unanimously tell you they feel safe here.
