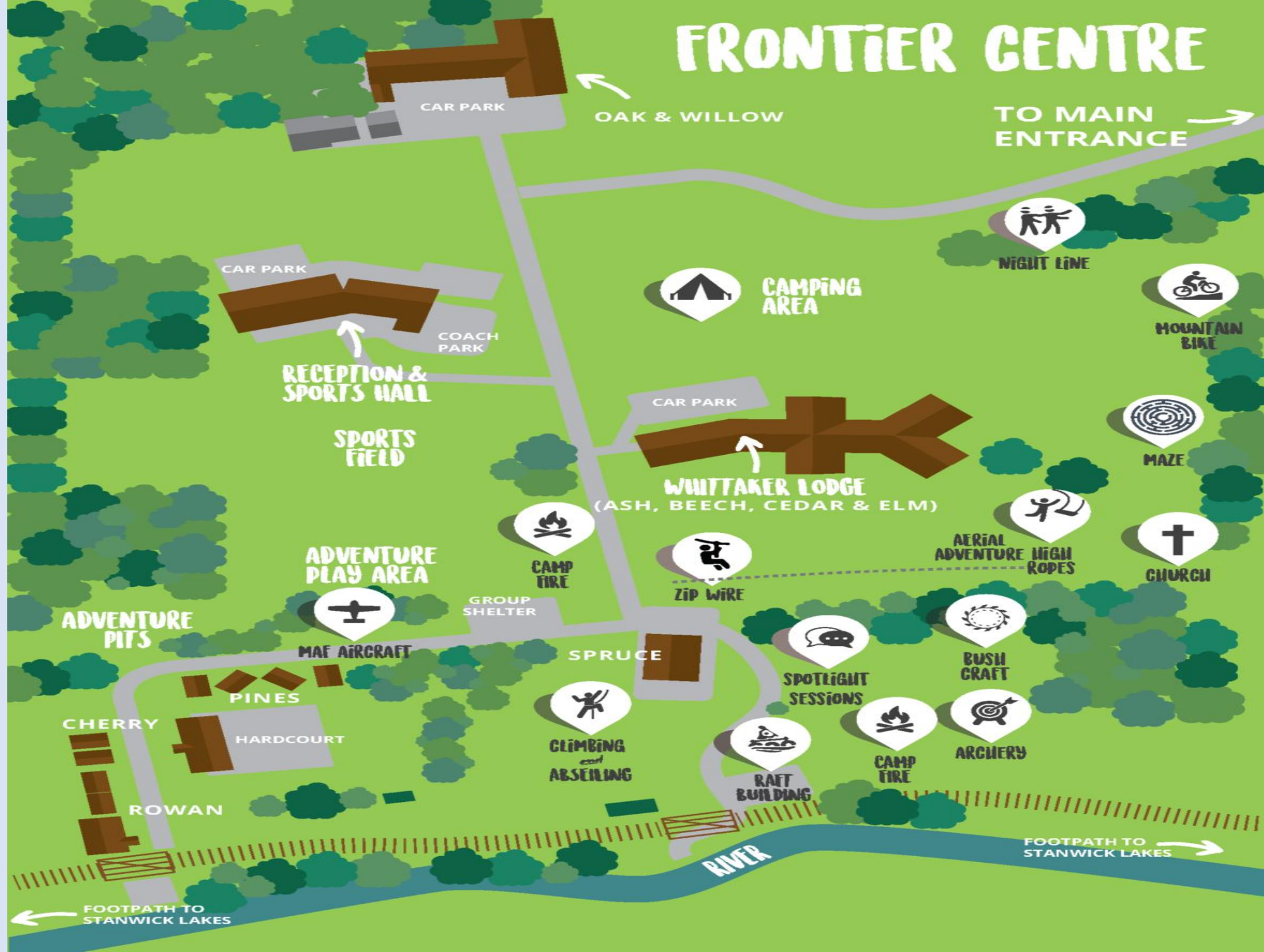

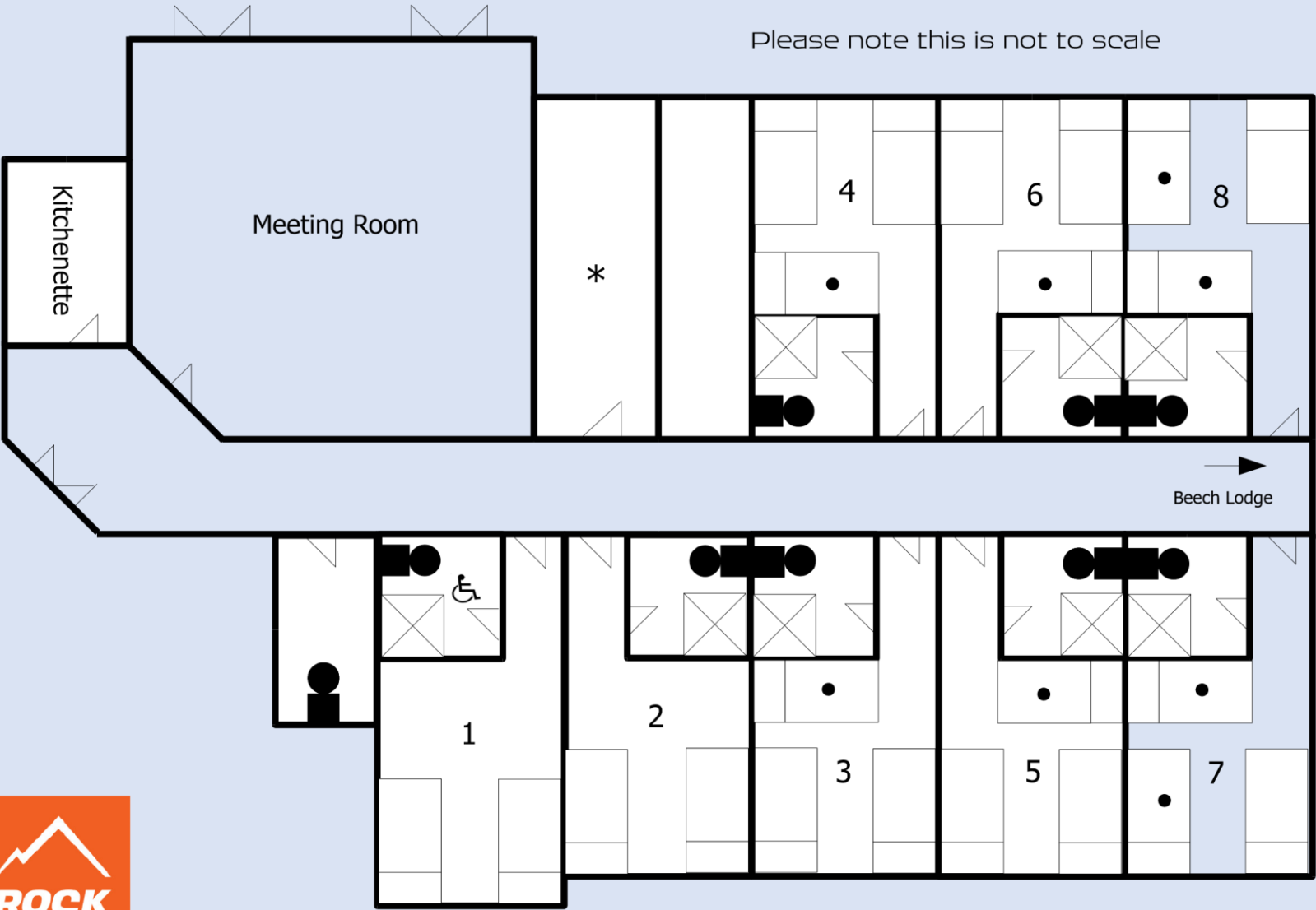

Room Allocation Sheet

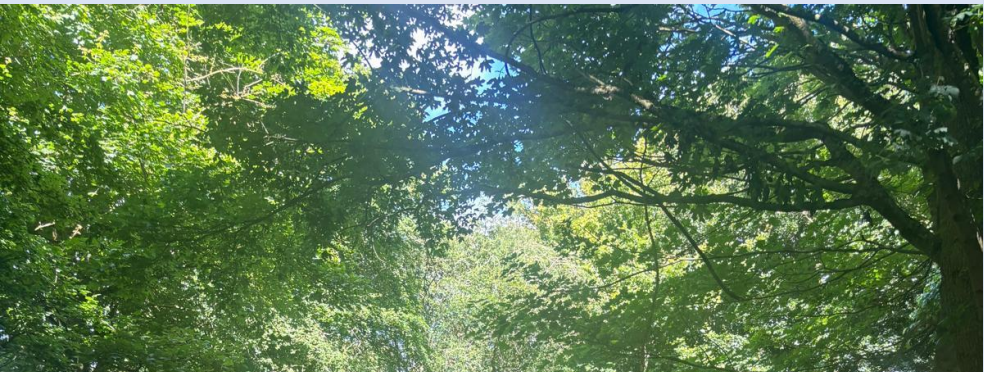

Costing
