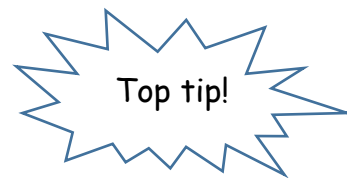


Fact or opinion?

Below are lots of pieces of information. Some are facts; some are opinions. Sort them into the table below. Remember – facts are something known or proven to be true. They are used as proof of an opinion, to support an argument, e.g. In 100 years there will be no rainforests. Opinions are what the writer believes to be true. These are based on feeling, rather than fact. They are used to try and convince someone that they are right, e.g. The world will end in 100 years.

Fact	Opinion
Forests are cleared to raise livestock or to plant other crops that can be sold, such as sugar cane and palm oil.	Rainforests are one of the world's most biodiverse areas.
It took 60 to 100 million years for Rainforests to evolve.	There are many positive reasons for cutting down trees.
Tropical deforestation is responsible for about 20% of world greenhouse gas emissions.	When the forests are felled, animals suffer.
Forests regulate the water cycle.	Forests play an important part in the water cycle.
In 100 years there will be no rainforests.	Rainforests are the world's most precious resource.
Forests help to control temperature	
Deforestation is when forests are destroyed by cutting and not replanted.

Forests provide most of the world's oxygen.	The rainforest can provide warmth and fuel for all of society. The rainforest is being cremated for human comfort - what about the animals?
A lot of deforestation is caused by the removal of all the trees from a forest for wood or fuel.	Loggers are slaying large land masses at an alarming rate.
