<u>English Writing</u>, <u>Reading and GPS - Our Topic: Grammar</u>. We have done a lot of lovely writing recently, but we now need to have a focus on some grammar. All of this week's lessons are revision from KS1 or from work already covered in Year 3 before lock down.

Monday <u>Inverted commas</u>

We have already done some work on inverted commas before lock down, so this should be revision. To help explain the grammar rules, we are going to use some video clips from the internet.

Start with a warm up with super-movers.



Tuesday <u>Co-ordinating Conjunctions</u>

These are little joining words that join parts of sentences together. There are only 7 of them. See below... A large poster is included as a support sheet.


