Lots of adverts use word play, to help them stay in your memory, so that you will act on what they want you to feel or do.

alliteration

Alliteration is a poetic device that uses the same letter sound at the start of adjacent or closely connected words in a sentence. It can add humour or help a phrase stick in the memory, so is often used in advertising.

The best four by four by far (Land Rover)

Made to make your mouth water (Opal Fruits)

rhyme

When two words rhyme they have word endings that sound similar. E.g. I love to write poems that rhyme. I do this often in my spare time It is used in advertising because words that rhyme, stay in the memory for longer. Ads are designed to make you think about them!

Beanz Meanz Heinz.(Baked beans)

No battery is stronger, longer. (Duracell)

Once you pop, you can't stop! (Pringles)

pun

A pun is a 'play on words,' where we use words that sound alike or have multiple meanings to write or say something funny. You often have to read them aloud, so you can hear what they are really saying!



Get N or get out (Nintendo 64)

They're G-r-r-eat! (Frosties)



repetition

Repetition is when a certain word, sentence or phase is written more than once. Repetition is used in adverts to help make it more interesting and to help create patterns, that stick in the memory.

Have a Break, Have a Kit Kat.

It Keeps Going, and Going, and Going... (Energizer)
