Adding the -ous suffix

Adding the -ous suffix forms adjectives that mean 'possessing' or full of a given quality'

RULE

- 1. When you add -ous to a word ending with 'e', drop the 'e' then add -ous.
- 2. If root word ends in 'y', replace the 'y' with 'i' then add -ous
- 3. If the root word ends with 'our', change to 'or', then add -ous.
- 4. If root word ends with 'on', remove on and add ous.
