

#### **Answers**;

#### Lesson 1

- 1. The first disciples gave up being fishermen, earning money by selling fish and the place they lived.
- 2. Come and follow me!
- 3. I will make you fishers of men.
- 4. It means that instead of catching fish for a living, the disciples will 'catch' people so that they will become followers of Jesus.



#### Lesson 2

- 1. Jesus was asking the disciples to show people how to follow God by living in a way that shows God's love.
- 2. Christians today do the same as the answer in number 1!
- 3. Both the original disciples and Christians today serve people by helping, teaching and caring for each other just like Jesus would.
- 4. Because you are ill, you could spread your germs and everyone become ill too.
- 5. Leprosy is a disease that has been known since biblical times. It causes nerve damage and muscle weakness that can lead to deformities, crippling, blindness and isolation. Every two minutes someone is diagnosed with leprosy. Many people think leprosy no longer exists, but it still occurs in more than 100 countries worldwide.
