LO: To know how to create tints, shades and tones of colours

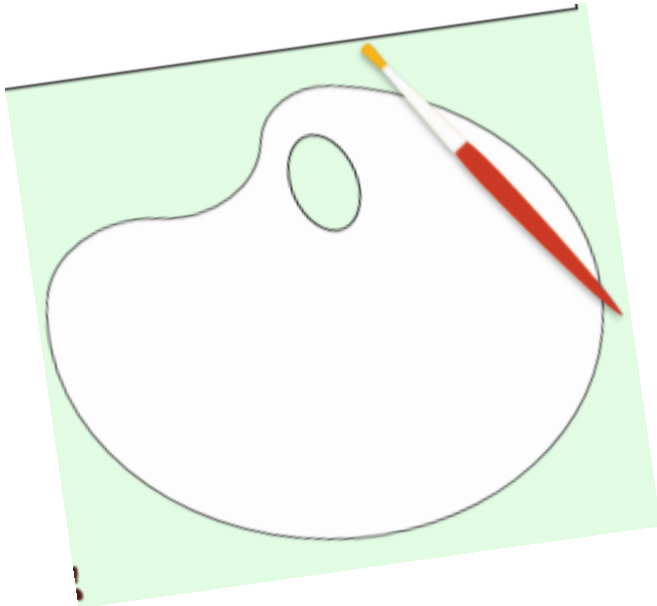
Following on from yesterday's activity

Create your own palette to create tints, shades and tones of Colour to match your chosen flower from the selection of pictures.

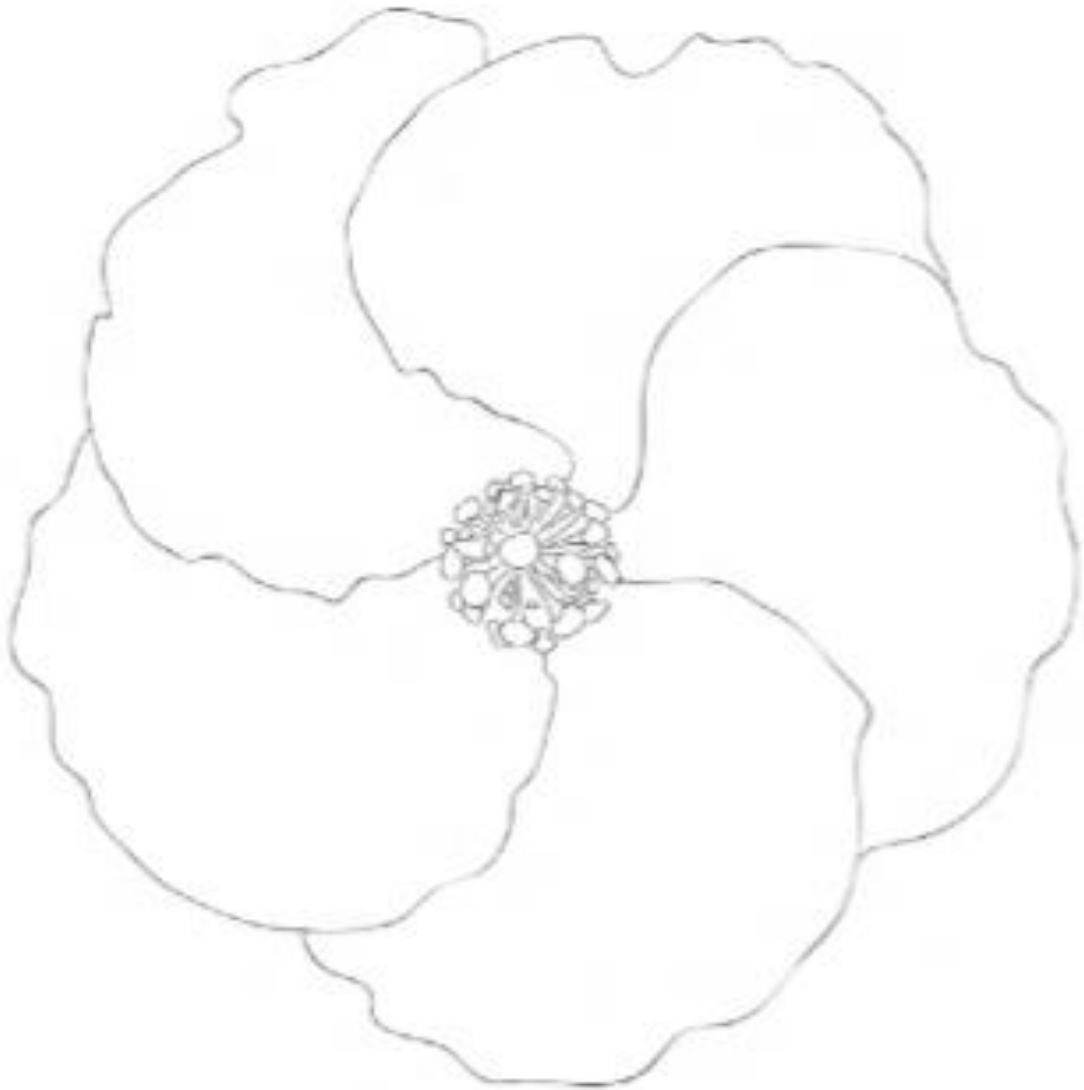
Then use them to add colour and depth to the flower outline.

You can either print off an outline or draw your own.



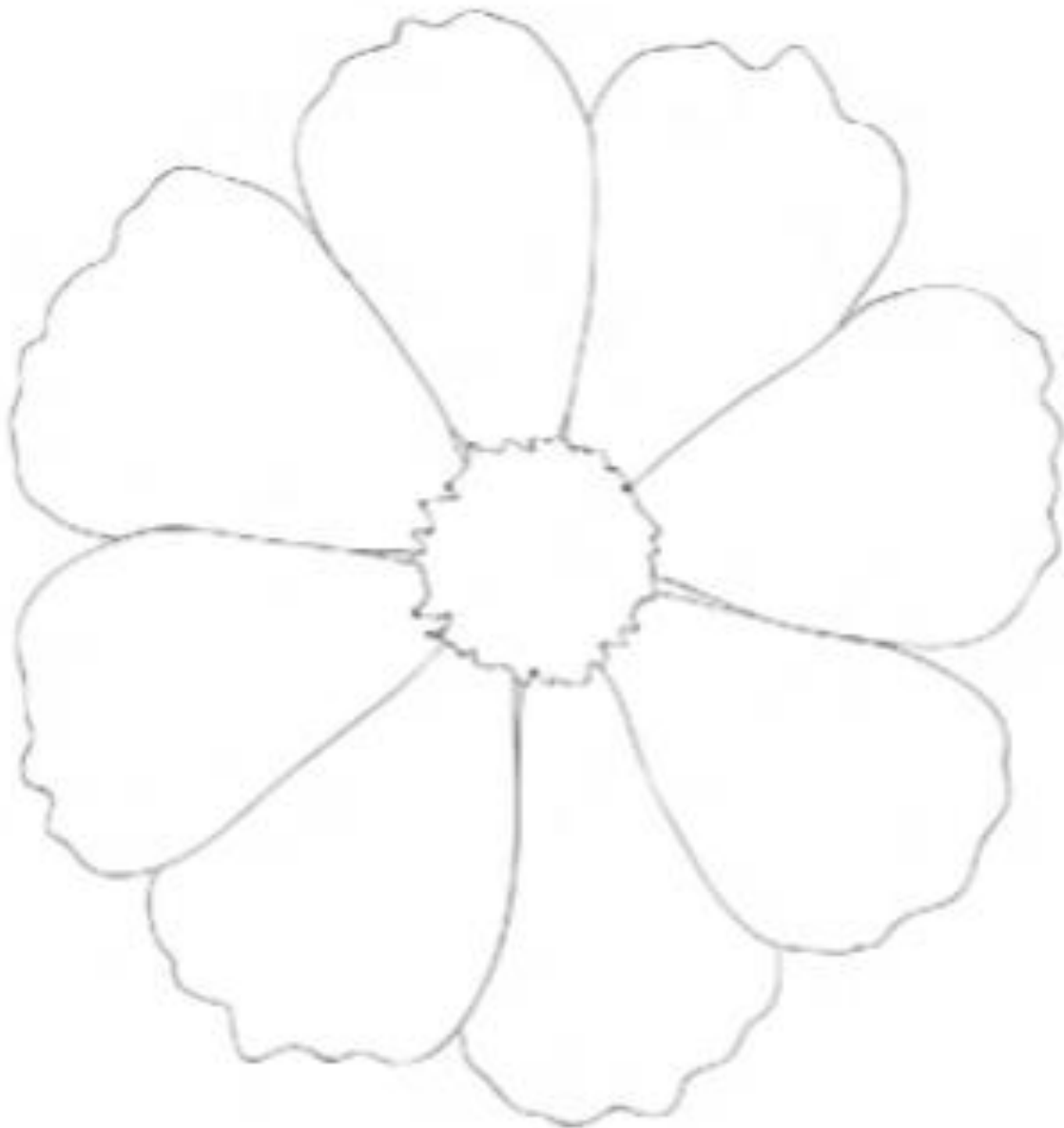


Hibiscus



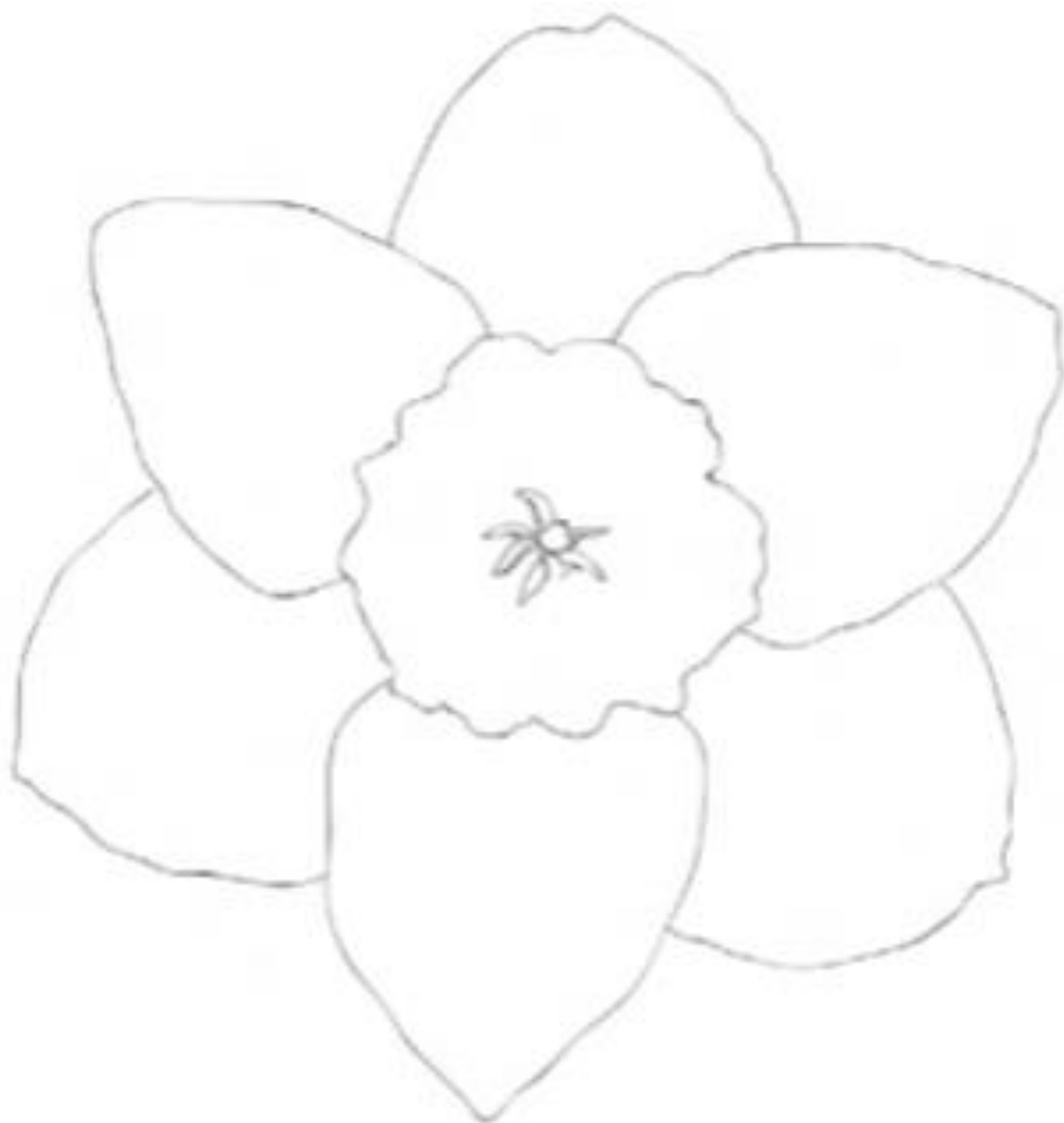


Cosmos



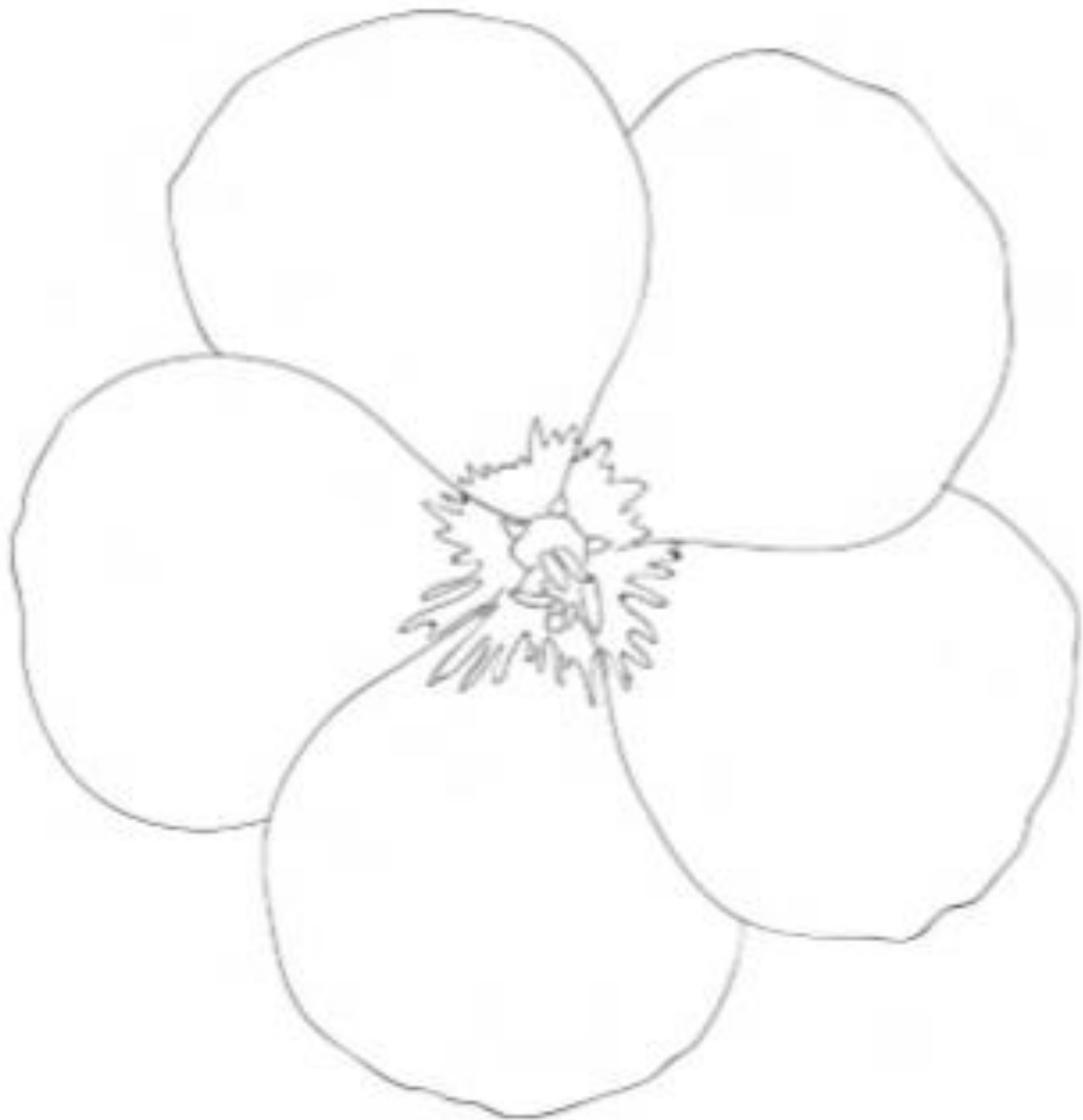


Daffodil

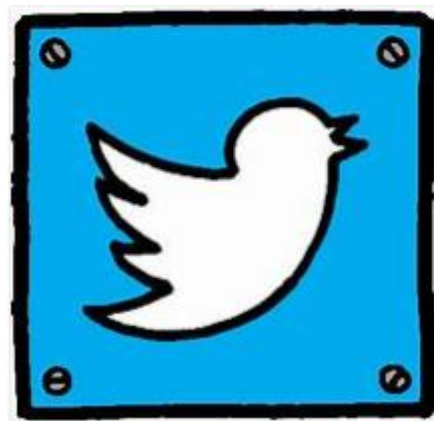
For those budding artists who would like a challenge, here are two more optional activities.
