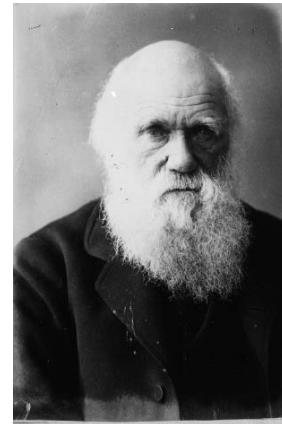
Over the term we will cover two Science units:
