





Guidance Document

Introduction

Church of England schools are committed to offering high quality collective worship. They are places that recognise and value collective worship as central to fostering a sense of community and to expressing the school's Christian vision. In practice this means that structure, planning, evaluation, participation, collaboration, and inspection of worship are all taken seriously by the school and by diocesan authorities.

This document has been produced to challenge, to guide and set expectations for Church school communities and diocesan authorities encouraging them to reflect on their practice and to ensure that collective worship remains the relevant and essential component of an education that enables all pupils to flourish and to 'live life in all its fullness' John 10:10.

In Church of England schools, collective worship is seen as more than a daily 'awe and wonder' moment. It is the unique heartbeat of the school and is offered as part of a wider opportunity for pupils and adults to encounter faith by engaging in conversations about God, both as individuals and together.

Collective worship

Reflects something special or separate from ordinary school activities. It will provide the pupils with the opportunity to consider spiritual and moral issues and to explore their own beliefs. Collective worship provides a focus for personal development and reflection. It is an opportunity to reflect on fundamental questions of life and to celebrate things of worth. The things that schools consider to be of worth (i.e. the school's values) are likely to be consistent with Christian and other religious values so it's not difficult to ensure that school worship themes are 'broadly Christian' in character.

Assembly

A meeting of a group of pupils and staff to share and develop a common ethos and values, to reinforce positive values, to value the different religious traditions reflected in the community and to encourage and value achievements. Part of each assembly will be an act of Collective Worship.

Collective worship

In Church of England schools

- Engage in an act of community
- Express praise and thanksgiving to God
- Be still and reflect
- Explore the big questions of life and respond to national events
- Foster respect and deepen spiritual awareness
- Reflect on the character of God and on the teachings of Christ
- Affirm Christian values and attitudes
- Share each other's joys and challenges
- Celebrate special times in the Christian calendar

In a CofE school collective worship is wholly of a Christian character



"In Church of England schools, collective worship is seen as more than a daily 'awe and wonder' moment. It is the unique heartbeat of the school and is offered as part of a wider opportunity for pupils and adults to encounter faith by engaging in conversations about God, both as individuals and together."

"We want pupils to leave school with a rich experience and understanding of Christianity, and we are committed to offering them an encounter with Jesus Christ and with Christian faith and practice in a way that enhances their lives...Collective worship in schools, including prayer, reading and reflecting on the Bible, liturgy, sacrament and experience of the musical and other imaginative riches of Christianity, provide a vital opportunity for this."

Christian and

- Christian elements of CW:
 - Bible as inspiration for themes and stories
 - Observing cycle of Church's year e.g., advent, Christmas, Easter
 - Learning and saying traditional prayers from different sources e.g., the Lord's Prayer and the Grace
 - Symbols and reflecting on their meaning e.g., the cross, bread and wine
 - Using Psalms with simple responses
 - Prayers of thanksgiving, intercession (praying for others) and asking for forgiveness (penitence)

.... and Anglican

- Using prayers from Common Worship
- Using Anglican sentences and responses e.g.:
 - The Lord is here / His Spirit is with us
 - Peace be with you/ and also with you
 - Go in peace to love and serve the Lord / In the name of Christ, Amen
 - In the name of the Father etc.
- Using the Collect of the day as a focus for worship
- Eucharist ?
- Encouraging links with the worship of the local parish church

Encourages local church community partnerships to support the school effectively in developing its provision for collective worship.


