## Year 4 Residential trip – April 2024



Whilst away on the residential, your children will be accompanied by experienced staff and first aiders who have run many residential. Our number one priority will be to ensure your children are well cared for. Before deciding to sign up for this trip, please consider the following as they are the frequently asked questions.

- **Can my child still come if they 'bed wet' in the night?** *Our staff are used to supporting children who have accidents. We are more than happy to take your child but please come and talk to us so we can discuss how to discretely support your child.*
- **Can my child contact me when they are away?** *One of the reasons for taking the children on a residential is to build resilience. Children do not contact their parents whilst on the trip and are not allowed to take a phone.*
- **What happens if my child needs first aid?** *Just like at school, we have experienced first aiders on the trip who will administer first aid on site. If further medical attention is needed, we will contact parents just as we would at school.*
- **What happens if my child needs medication?** *A medical form will be sent out to you before the trip. Please fill this in and bring in the medication to school before-hand, and staff can administer it as required.*
- **What happens if my child is homesick?** *Staff are on call 24/7 should your child need them even during the night and will always look after them. As we do not send children home for this, please consider whether your child is ready to stay away from home. If this is going to be difficult for them, it may be better to wait until they are a little older before signing up to a residential.*

Just as in school, we expect children to behave well at all times. Whilst completing activities, it is essential that children follow all instructions given. If your child's behaviour potentially puts either themselves or others at risk, you may be asked to collect your child from the trip.

By signing up to the trip and paying a deposit you are confirming that you have read these frequently asked questions.
