Read Write Inc

Intervention Spotlight

In this section we would like to explain a little more about the different interventions your child may receive in school. Our first spotlight is 'Read, Write Inc'.

Read Write Inc. Phonics is the UK's leading synthetic phonics programme. It is designed so all children:

- Reach the expected standard of the phonics screening check,
- Develop reading fluency and read with comprehension
- Develop cooperative behaviour and articulate their ideas and understanding
- Spell and write with confidence

If your child attends this intervention in school, they are likely to receive around 20 minutes, four times a week. As a school, we find this intervention is extremely successful and it shows in children's progress.

ADHD Solutions Support Groups

You can access support and advice from their Specialist Family Support Team who run monthly term time support groups for parent/carers. These groups are a great opportunity to meet new people and share your experiences in an informal environment.
